- **Resources and Infrastructure:** Details on trainers, facilities.
- **Monitoring & Evaluation:** Approach for tracking progress and measuring the impact of the training.
- **Financial Details:** Turnover of last 3yrs, average 2Cr.

Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated based on:

- Experience and expertise in relevant training domains.
- Quality and feasibility of the proposed training plan.
- Cost efficiency and financial stability.
- Organizational capacity to deliver at the required scale.
- Execution plan with details of Centres in Bokaro
